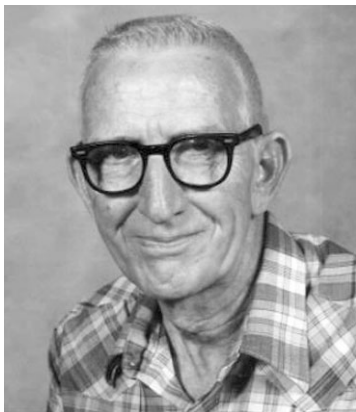


JAMES FLOYD HUDDLESTON
