

ALBERT C. "AL" SCOTT

1931-2010

BRIDGEPORT: Albert C. "Al" Scott, 79, a retired soil conservationist for the U.S. Department of Agriculture died Wednesday, July 21, 2010, in Decatur.

Al was born June 25, 1931 to Dr. Verne and Anna Pearl (Kern) Scott in Stephenville, Texas. He married Barbara Ann Wood on July 3, 1954 in Stephenville. Al graduated Texas A & M in 1954, serving four years in the Corp of Cadets. Al served as 2nd Lieutenant in the U.S. Army during the Korean War. He also served on the Wise County Soil and Conservation Board from 1988 to 2009; the Bridgeport City Council from 1992 to 2010; and Wise Water Board from 2000 to present. Al was named Citizen of the Year in 2005 by the Bridgeport Chamber of Commerce. He was an elder of the First Presbyterian Church in Bridgeport for 43 years.

He was preceded in death by his parents and his brother, Vern A. Scott, Jr.

Survivors include his wife of 56 years, Ann Scott of Bridgeport; son, Dr. David Scott and wife Karen of Albuquerque, NM; daughter, Becca Scott Kay and husband Brent Kenneth of Princeton; sister-n-law, Eva Jo Scott of Stephenville; nephew, Robert V. Scott of Grand Lake, CO; niece, Susan Reeves of Edmond, OK; other relatives and a host of friends.
