ALVORD: Edwin “Ed” Wilfred Strange, 83, a local business owner, died on Thursday, November 11, 2010, in Decatur.

Ed was born June 20, 1927, to Fearrel and Barnetta (Pickett) Strange in Alvord. He married Elizabeth Ann Watson on November 6, 1948, in Denton.
