Born Sept. 23, 1922, in Decatur to Elizabeth Penn Dixon Ward and Jesse Lawrence Ward, she attended Decatur public schools, Baylor University, Decatur Baptist College (where her father served as president), North Texas State Teachers College and Texas State College for Women, where she earned an undergraduate degree in education. Robertson relocated to Lubbock where she earned a master's degree from Texas Technological College.

She taught in Texas public schools before retiring from Socorro Independent School District as director of special education. Upon retirement, she moved to Denison where she established and operated a craft store, Rob's Attic.

She was a member of First Presbyterian Church in Denison, where she taught Sunday school and her Circle meetings.

Robertson was preceded in death by husbands Gene Kincaid and W.A. Robertson; sisters Pearl Ward and Ruth Reed; brother Penn Dixon; son Paul Robertson; and grandson Kirk Kincaid.

She is survived by children Gene Kincaid and wife, Judy, Elizabeth McKay, Bobbie Shultz and husband, Steve, and Ruth Robertson; a niece; nine grandchildren; and 15 great-grandchildren.
