Funeral for John Thomas “Tom” Syler, 77, of Denton was to be 2 p.m. Wednesday, March 2, at Singing Oaks Church of Christ in Denton with Don Browning and Ross Thompson officiating. Burial was to follow at Jackson Cemetery in Krum.
