
Streller, Richard | 1943-2012

Memorial service for Richard Streller, 69, of Decatur is 11 a.m. Saturday, Aug. 25, at First United Methodist Church in Decatur with private interment at Restland Cemetery in Dallas.

Streller died Sunday, Aug. 19, 2012, in Decatur.

Born Aug. 2, 1943, in Perry, Okla., to Paul and Lena Streller, he served in the U.S. Air Force. He graduated with a degree in accounting from Texas A&M University and passed the Certified Public Accountant exam, earning a national medal.

He was a president and chief executive officer for Hogan Systems, Saddlebrook Corp. and Shared Financial Systems, specializing in software for the banking and financial industries.

Streller retired in 1992, then volunteered as a trustee and president of the board of the University of the Ozarks, with Habitat for Humanity, North Dallas Shared Ministries, WARM (Wise Area Relief Mission), Wise Hope and Hope Chest domestic violence task force and Helpful Hands (at First United in Decatur), helping homebound individuals with housing repairs.

Streller served as an elder with Bentwood Trail Presbyterian Church in Dallas and was an active member in local missions at First United.

He is survived by his wife of 36 years, Scottie Kennedy; brother Don and wife, Sue; sister Janet; sons Steve Streller and Scott Streller and wife, Diana; daughters Teresa Shaw and husband, Larry, and Lisa Streller; five grandchildren; and three great-grandchildren.
