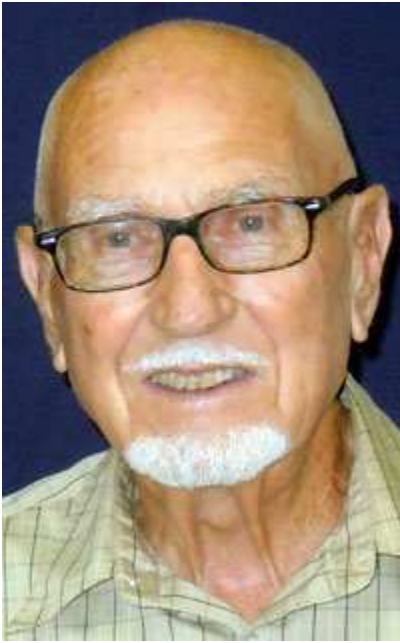


Stringfellow, B.J. | 1930-2013
