David Leslie "Les" Scourfield, 84, of Paradise, died Saturday, June 4, 2016, in Lewisville.

Memorial service is 7 p.m. Tuesday, June 28, at Garden Ridge Church of Christ in Lewisville with the Rev. Andrew Deister officiating.

Les was born Aug. 30, 1932, in Carmarthen, South Wales, to Gwendaline Mary and Samuel Scourfield. He married Margaret R. Kenaghan April 3, 1953, in Birmingham, England.

Les left Britain in 1963 and moved to Toronto, Canada, followed by a move to Chula Vista, Calif., in 1967. His immigration to the United States was sponsored by an American aircraft company due to his trade as a master toolmaker. His career eventually led him to Texas where he worked for General Dynamics – later Lockheed Martin – for 20 years, retiring in 1997.

Les was preceded in death by his parents; and brother.

He is survived by his wife of 63 years, Margaret Scourfield; sister Jean Neary of Ontario; son David Scourfield and wife, Micheline, of Valley Center, Calif.; daughter Kim Scourfield of Paradise; son Michael Scourfield and wife, Susan, of Postoak; daughter Tracy Scourfield of Lewisville; sister Jean Neary; 11 grandchildren; 15 great-grandchildren; and six great-great-grandchildren.
