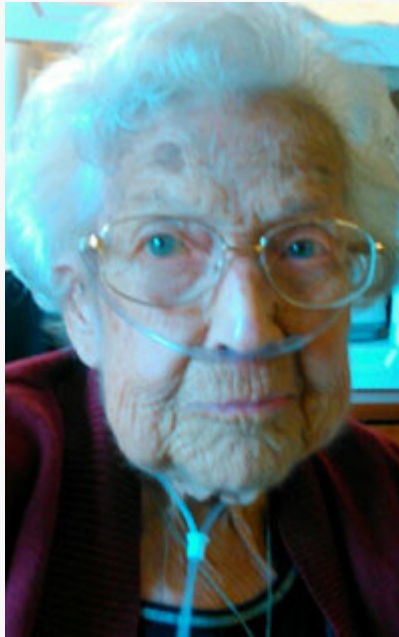


## Solomon, Ruby Frances (Bragg) | 1929-2017
