Lois (Skinner) Blisseck, 93, died Saturday, Aug. 4, 2018.

Lois was born on Feb. 17, 1925, to Jesse James and Vera Ella Skinner. Lois grew up on an island in Florida with her two brothers, Thomas James (TJ) and Fred, and her sister, Willie Lee. She left Florida at the age of 17 when she met Joseph Leo Blisseck in 1942. They were married for 61 years at the time of his death in 2004.
