W.B. was born Dec. 9, 1929, in Wise County to Burrell and Ola Lee (Nesmith) Arrington. He worked for 13 years as a plumber, even

owning his own company. He also had a dairy farm for 18 years and bought and sold cattle for several years. But he’s probably best remembered as a sheriff’s deputy for the Jack County Sheriff’s Office, serving in law enforcement for more than 20 years.

He was a longtime member of the Masons. In fact, he’d received his 65-year pin, and was a 3rd degree Master Mason.

On Dec. 10, 1994, he married Sibyl (Marlett) Todd. The couple were members of Bible Baptist Church in Bridgeport.

He leaves behind his wife, Sibyl (Marlett) Arrington of Bridgeport; son Eddy Don Arrington and wife, Linda, of Houston; daughter Sherry Jackson and husband, Bob, of Euless; sons Jerry Hartsell and wife, Sharon, of Fort Worth and Mike Hartsell and wife, Christy, of Bridgeport; grandchildren Michael Arrington, Christy Arrington, Garrett Arrington, Kelly Jackson, Traci South, Scotty Hale, Jessica Henson and Josh Hartsell; and 11 great-grandchildren.
