For many years, Wayne and Billie owned and operated Billington's Grocery on Texas 114 in Bridgeport, where high school students for many years enjoyed their homemade sandwiches and other treats. Somehow a sandwich never tasted quite as good as one from their store. The store closed down in the early 2000s to make way for a more modern convenience store, and its loss is still talked about today.

Billie is survived by her daughter Louise Miller and husband, Charles, of Bridgeport; grandchildren Emily Boyd and husband, Kevin, of Austin, Sandra Thornhill of Austin, Carol Thornhill of San Angelo, and Jason Billington of Denver, Colo.; five great-grandchildren, and two great-great grandchildren.
