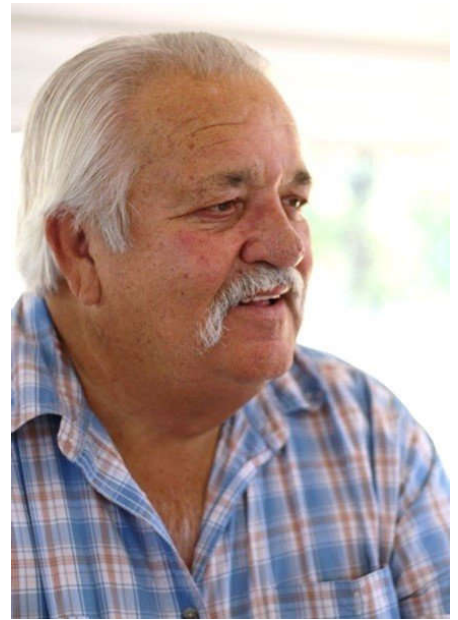




Warner, Norman L.
