

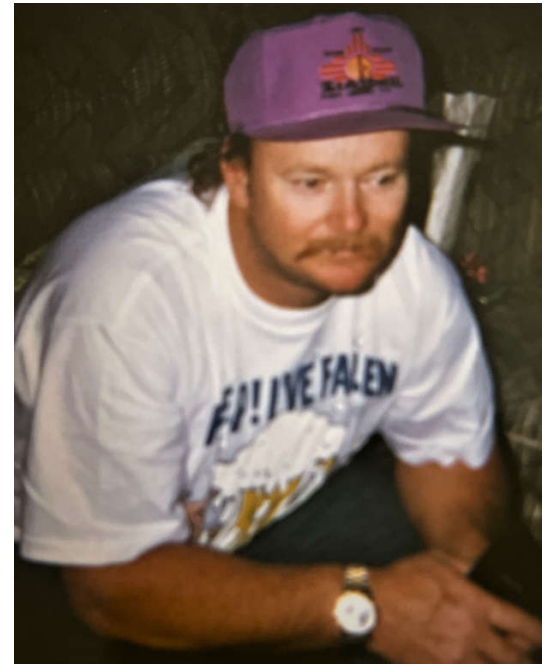


Brown, Johnny Lee
