

Brooks, Jackie Morris 1942-2023

Jack worked for 42 years as an elevator mechanic for Otis, Montgomery, Kone and Fort Worth Elevator, a company owned by his father-in-law, who taught Jack the elevator trade. He supported his wife's love of horses and barrel racing, spending many weekends hauling horses to equestrian events and was a favorite "gate man" at barrel races in Texas, Oklahoma and Louisiana. He was an avid sportsman, playing football in high school and college and later baseball. He loved golf, travel and dominoes. He could fix anything and didn't have an off button. He was generous with his time, always busy helping friends and family, working on trucks, tractors, mowers, anything mechanical

as well as he and Sharon's home property in Decatur. He had just mowed a neighbor's property the morning that he died.
