Funeral for Kenneth Wayne Terrell Sr., 77, of Clyde was July 5. Burial was at Oakwood Cemetery in Wewoka, Okla.

Terrell died Friday, July 1, 2011, in Clyde.

Born Feb. 4, 1934, in Wewoka to Grady and Beatrice Hopkins Terrell, he graduated from Wewoka High School in 1952 and attended East Central College in Ada.

Terrell entered the U.S. Army at Fort Chaffee, Ark., in 1954. He made rank to master sergeant and was given a direct field commission to first lieutenant. He received promotions to captain, major and chief warrant officer I, II, III and IV, and was the first to earn 13 different ranks.

Terrell married Barbara Ann Baker July 19, 1954, in Fort Chaffee. He taught Sunday school and military classes at the University of Oklahoma and served as president of the Lions Club and Little League Baseball of Arkadelphia, Ark. He was an Oklahoma Sooners fan, spent time with his family and friends and went bowling and golfing. Terrell is survived by his wife, Dorothy Terrell of Seminole, Okla.; son Kenneth W. Terrell Jr. and wife, Vicky, of Decatur; daughters Ronda Hatchett and husband, Byron, of Clyde, Tammy Watts and husband, William, of Texarkana, and Karen Hudgens and husband, James, of Shreveport, La.
