

Weehunt, Rhynold Lee | 1930-2011

Funeral for Rhynold Lee Weehunt Sr., 80, of Holland was Feb. 21 at the First Baptist Church in Holland with Michael Fortson and Danny Shaver officiating.

Weehunt died Friday, Feb. 18, 2011, at Holland. A graveside service with military honors followed at Holland Cemetery.

Born Oct. 17, 1930, at Morgan to Roy Loyd and Bernice Weehunt, he married Bobbie Adell Cooper April 8, 1955, in Weatherford. Weehunt served in the U.S. Air Force and after being discharged in 1952, he worked for Western Electric. He became a manager at Comanche County Telephone Co. in 1978 and retired in 1992. He began his telephone career in Wise County in 1958.

Weehunt owned a peanut farm, was a deacon in the Church of Christ, a volunteer fire chief and a member of Rotary International and the Decatur Jaycees. He fished and traveled.

He was preceded in death by brother Bobby Elvin Weehunt.

Weehunt is survived by his wife; son Rhynold Lee Weehunt Jr. of Brownwood; daughter Connie Adell Weehunt-Hagood of Holland; grandsons Shannon Knox Hagood and wife, Betty Lisa, of Holland, Rhynold Lee Weehunt III of Odessa and Michael Madison Weehunt of Houston; great-grandson William Knox Hagood of Holland; brother Ben Roy Weehunt; and sister Reta Ann Weehunt Shaver.
