Funeral for Lavon Wolff, 74, of Bridgeport is 11 a.m. Wednesday, July 11, at Balsora Baptist Church with Glenn Connell officiating. Burial will follow at West Bridgeport Cemetery.

Wolff died Monday, July 9, 2012, in Bridgeport.

Born Dec. 13, 1937, in Santo to Flora Evangeline (Irvin) and Jewel A. Long, she married Jimmy Wolff Sept. 9, 1955.

She was a homemaker and an Avon representative for 30 years. Wolff taught Sunday school for more than 50 years and was a member of the Women's Missionary Union, the Baptist Women and Girls in Action.

She gardened and canned and raised a myriad of animals and crops on her 100-acre farm, including chickens, peacocks, quails, cows and pecans.

She was preceded in death by her husband on Dec. 25, 2000, and her sister, Lora Cobb.
