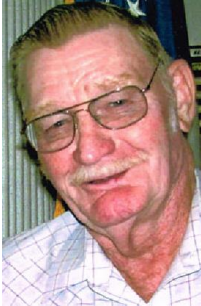


## **Thomas Green Cash | 1936-2014**
