

Dean Albert Campbell | 1925-2015

Dean “Dino” Albert Campbell, 90, of Arlington died Saturday, Sept. 5, 2015.

A memorial service is 2 p.m. Sunday, Sept. 13, at King of Glory Lutheran Church on Sandy Lane in Forth Worth. His ashes will be interred at the Dallas National Cemetery.

Dino was born in Bay City, Mich. to Walter Campbell and Dorothea (Mann) Campbell. He grew up in Bay City with his seven siblings.

Dino served in the Pacific Theater in World War II with the First Division Marine Corps. After the war, he married Ramona “Mona” Ervin (n e Dial). They built a home in Arlington in 1960 and raised their two children there.

Dino retired from the U.S. Postal Service and enjoyed many years competing in horseshoe pitching tournaments across the country. On Dec. 21, 1982, Dino became involved with AA and was able to help change many lives and extend his family.

Dino was preceded in death by his wife, Ramona “Mona” Campbell; brothers Clayton “Clayte” Campbell, Milo Campbell, Colen “Coke” Campbell and Miles Campbell; and sisters Annette Jones and Lucille Churchill.

He is survived by his eldest sister, Sue “Memes” McCorkle of Portland, Ore.; son William Ray Campbell of Rhome; daughter Linda Kay Perkins of Boyd; two granddaughters; and four great-grandchildren. He is also survived by his beloved dog, Big Guy.
