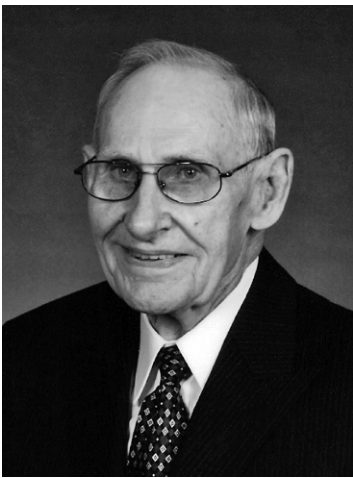


J.W. (JOHN) COLLINS

CHICO: J.W. (John) Collins, 87, of Chico, died Sunday, October 4, 2015 in Decatur.

John was born April 24, 1928 in Alvord, Texas to Zack Lee and Velar Ellen (Anderson) Collins. John served in the US Army during the Korean Conflict. A few years after he returned stateside, he married Lois Ogle in 1957, on his birthday, April 24. He spent 28 years with TXI at the Bridgeport plant in mobile maintenance.
