

Infant killed in Thursday rollover

An infant was killed and four people were injured in a rollover on U.S. Highway 81/287 near County Road 1595 north of Alvord Thursday morning.

Department of Public Safety Trooper Chesley Womack said a Toyota pickup towing a trailer was traveling northbound around 9:30 when the trailer began to skid, dragging the truck east off the roadway where it hit a line of trees and rolled several times. The truck came to rest upside down suspended by a tree. The trailer was thrown out of sight. Womack said 4-month-old Marinia Dominguez sustained fatal injuries in the wreck. She was transported via ambulance to Cook Children's Hospital in Fort Worth where she was pronounced dead.

Other occupants in the vehicle included parents Juan and Deanna Dominguez and children Nathaniel and Olivia Dominguez. Juan and Olivia were taken by ambulance to Wise Health System in Decatur, and Deanna and Nathaniel were taken to John Peter Smith Hospital in Fort Worth, also by ground ambulance.

Northbound traffic slowed to a crawl while crews from Alvord and Decatur fire departments worked to clear the scene. Another rollover, several miles south of the fatal crash, occurred when a southbound GMC SUV towing a trailer with several motorcycles lost control of the trailer while changing lanes and left the roadway, rolling into the median and landing upside down facing north. DPS Trooper Paul Zaragoza said no one was injured. Alvord Fire Department and Wise County EMS responded to the scene.
