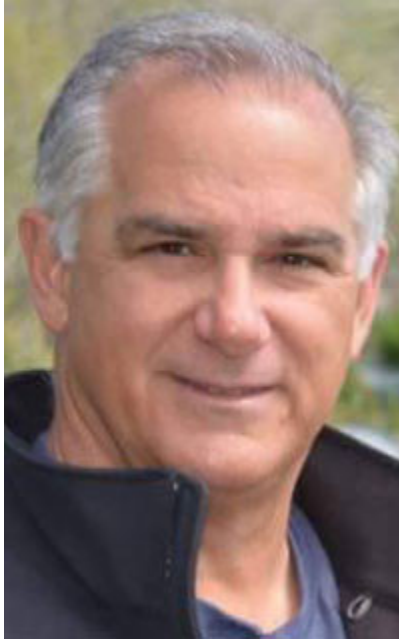


## **Louis Michael Doyle | 1958-2016**
