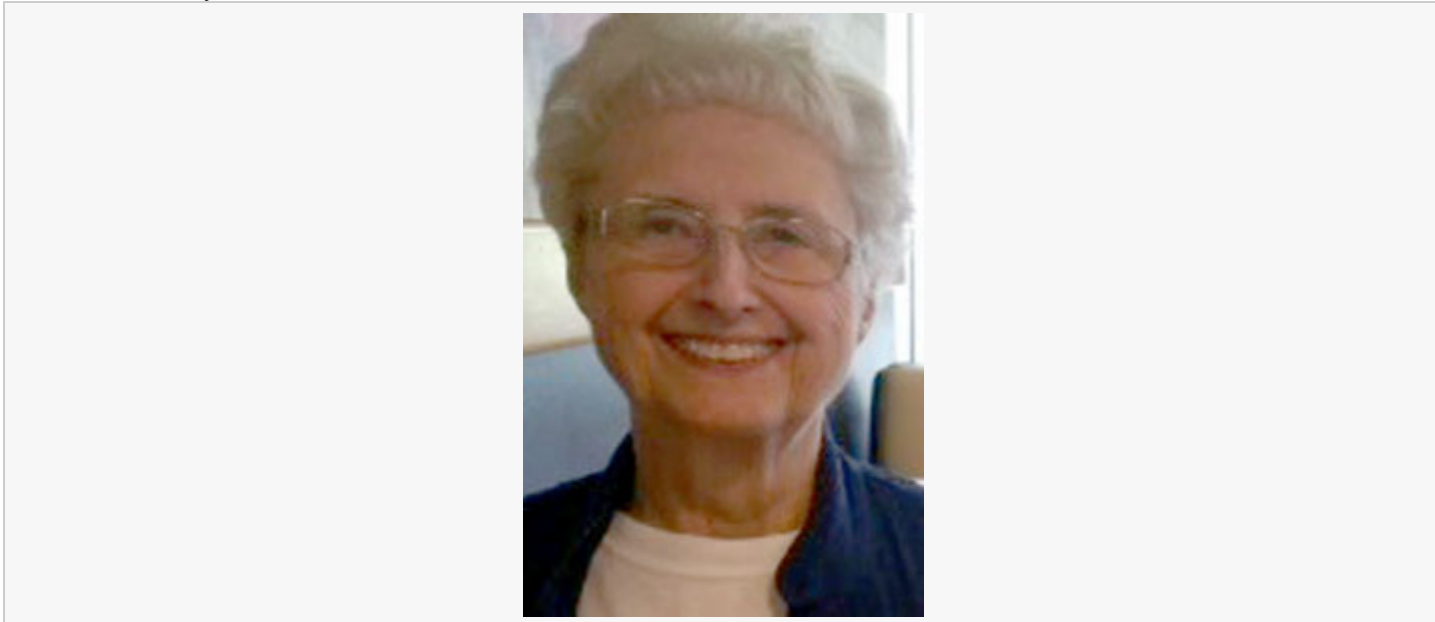


Chase, Dorothy S. 'Dottie' (Schryer) | 1937-2017

Dorothy S. "Dottie" Chase, 80, of Willard, Ohio, died Sunday, Nov. 5, 2017, in Willard.
