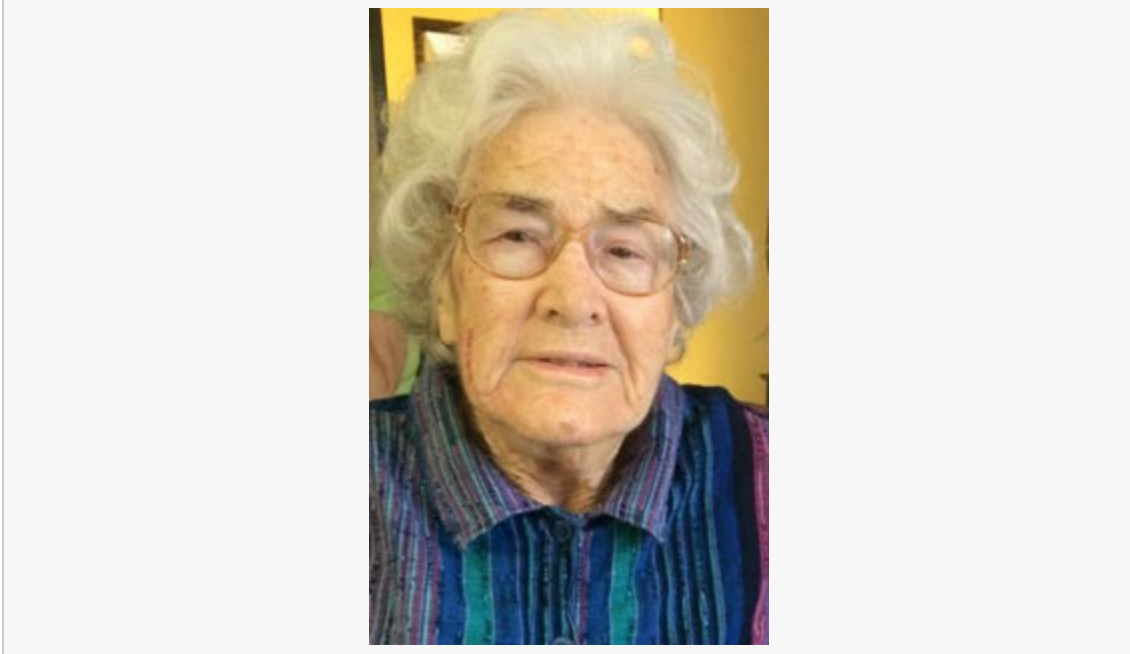


Cole, Jessie Mae (Hardee) | 1928-2017
