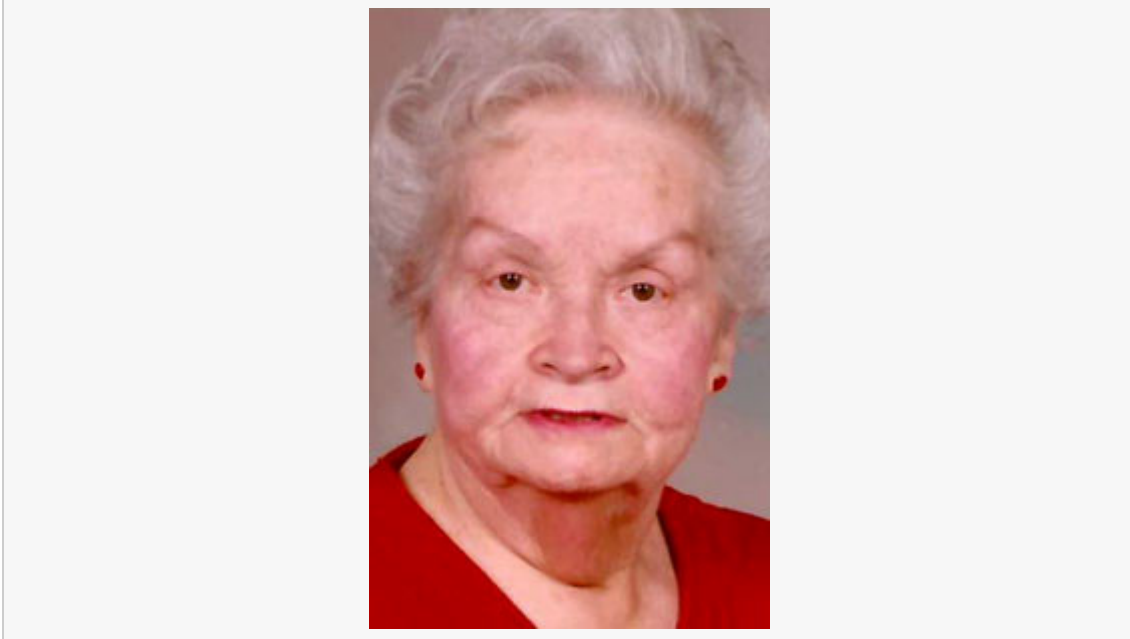


Cook, Eula Mae (Reeves) | 1924-2017
