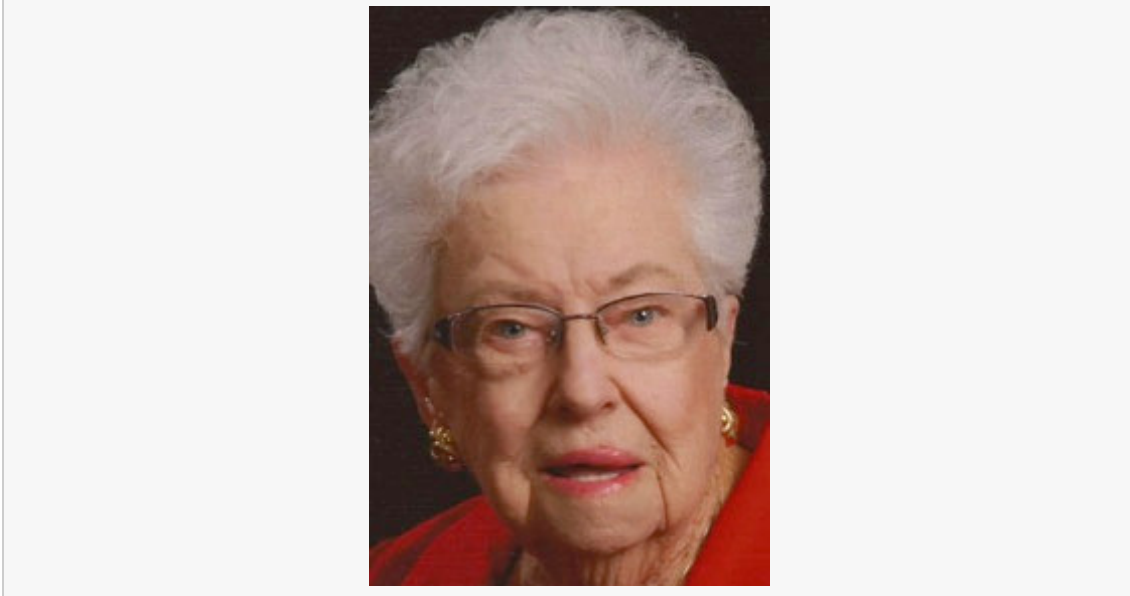


Davis, Mary Elaine (Suggs) | 1924-2017
