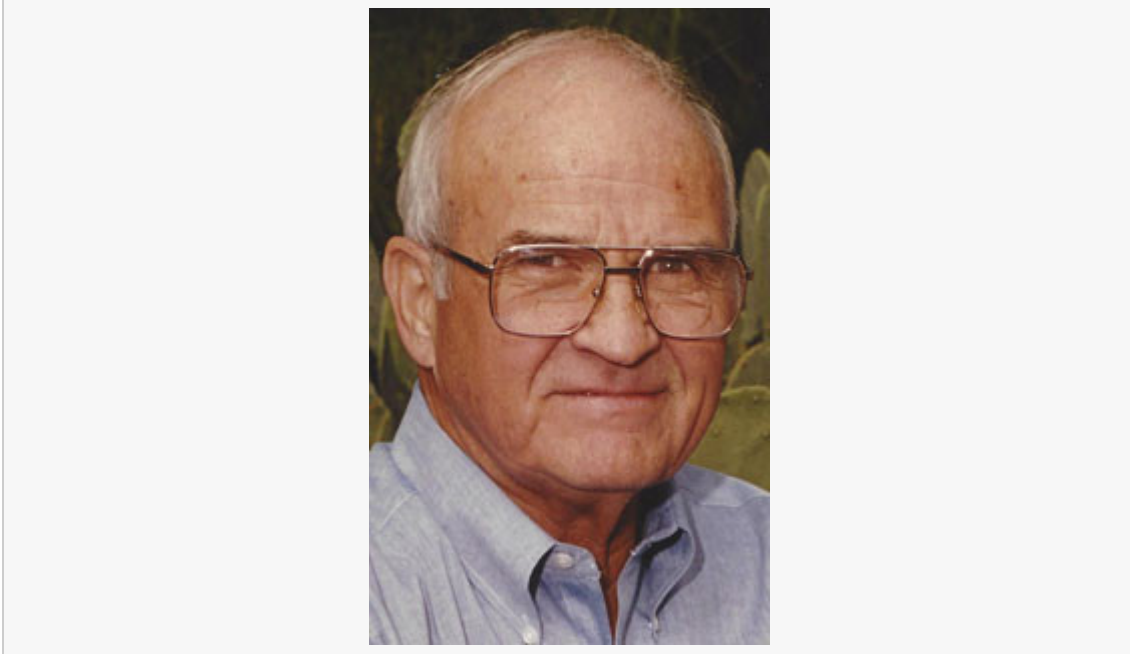


## Duvall, Bobby Don 'Bob' | 1936-2017
