## Two die from wreck injuries

Two men involved in accidents on Wise County roads last week later died from injuries sustained in the crashes.

John E. Nutt, 80, of Runaway Bay, who was involved in a two-vehicle wreck Dec. 18, has died from his injuries, according to police.

Nutt was the driver of a Ford F-150 pickup that pulled out onto U.S. 380 from Bluebird Lane in front of an eastbound Nissan Rogue and was struck in the driver's side, according to Runaway Bay Police Chief Stephen Reynolds. The accident happened just before 9 a.m.

The impact caused Nutt's pickup to flip onto its side.

Nutt and a passenger, Allie Nutt, were taken to Medical Center Denton. Two people in the other vehicle – Vernon and Shirley Cody of Graham – were also injured and taken to hospitals.

Funeral for Nutt is pending at Hawkins Funeral Home in Bridgeport.

Joshua Daniel, 23, of Azle died Dec. 22 at John Peter Smith Hospital in Fort Worth.

Daniel was transported to the hospital from a single-vehicle crash on U.S. 81/287 at the Wise and Tarrant County line shortly after midnight Dec. 22.

Daniel was driving a 1997 Dodge Ram northbound on U.S.. 81/287.

"For an undetermined reason, the Dodge traveled onto the northbound shoulder and then overcorrected causing the Dodge to overturn multiple times before coming to rest in the southbound lanes of travel," said Department of Public Safety spokesman Sgt. Ricky Hunter.

Daniel was ejected from the vehicle.

Passenger George Yawakie, 34, of Haslet was also transported to John Peter Smith with undisclosed injuries.
