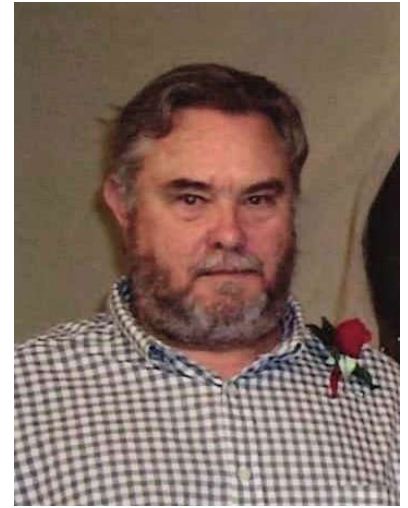




Graybill, Mark
